

**2013-14 Junior PSAT Data**(an est. 1.5 million college bound juniors take the test): We had 21 juniors participate (we usually average around 6-8). Percentiles are based on where students fall nationwide. Section scores range from 20-80.

### **Math**

We had **8** juniors score in the **72 percentile or higher** in the **Math** section (**72, 72, 72, 72, 78, 78, 81, and 89** percentile ranges). We had **13** juniors score a **49 or higher** on the math section, which was the average score across the nation in 2012 (**52, 52, 52, 53, 53, 55, 55, 55, 56, 58, 58, 59, and 64**). We had **7** juniors score between **41-49** (**41, 41, 42, 43, 43, 43, and 48**).

### **Critical Reading**

We had **5** juniors score in the **70 percentile or higher** in the **Critical Reading** section (**70, 74, 83, 88, and 90** percentile ranges). We had **8** juniors score a **48 or higher** on the **Critical Reading** section, which was the average score across the nation in 2012 (**49, 50, 53, 55, 54, 59, 62, and 63**). We had **9** juniors score between **40-48** (**40, 41, 41, 41, 42, 42, 45, 45, and 46**).

### **Writing Skills**

We had **1** junior score in the **71 percentile** in the **Writing Skills** section. We had **5** juniors score a **47** or higher on the **Writing Skills** section, which was the average score across the nation in 2012 (**47, 47, 50, 50, and 53**). We had **11** juniors score between **41-46** (**41, 42, 43, 43, 43, 43, 43, 45, 45, 45, and 46**).

**Selection Index Percentage** (based on Selection Index Scores in Math, Critical Reading, and Writing Skills)

We had **5** juniors score in the **71 percentile or higher** (**71, 71, 72, 75, and 78**).  
We had **4** juniors score between the **55-65 percentile** (**55, 59, 65, and 65**).
